The Advancing HIV & AIDS Epidemic Control (AHEC) Activity is a U.S. Department of State-funded initiative led by IntraHealth International to strengthen HIV prevention, care, and treatment services across South Sudan. The project emphasizes community-led responses, strategic case finding, retention in care, and the delivery of high-quality, client-centered HIV services.


As our Clinical Service Coordinator, you will provide targeted on-site clinical mentorship, supportive supervision, and technical assistance to AHEC-supported health facilities. Your role strengthens the quality and outcomes of HIV services across the clinical cascade in alignment with Ministry of Health and donor guidelines.

### KEY TECHNICAL FOCUS AREAS

- HIV case identification and index testing
- Rapid linkage to ART initiation
- Retention in care and continuity of treatment
- Viral load coverage and suppression
- Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) scale-up
- PMTCT and Early Infant Diagnosis (EID) services
- TB/HIV integration
- Advanced HIV Disease (AHD) management
- Pediatric and adolescent HIV care
- Data use for clinical and programmatic decision-making

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

**Clinical Leadership and Service Delivery at site level**



- Provide technical leadership and mentorship to health facility teams.
- Support site level implementation of differentiated service delivery models and Granular Site Management (GSM) approaches.
- Ensure compliance with MOH and PEPFAR guidelines.

#### **PMTCT & Early Infant Diagnosis (EID)**

- Strengthening PMTCT and EID services, including maternal viral load monitoring.
- Mentor staff on PMTCT/EID protocols, documentation, cohort monitoring, and quality improvement practices.

#### **PrEP Implementation for pregnant and breastfeeding mothers**

- Lead the implementation of PrEP in all AHEC supported health facilities and document lessons learned.
- Integrate PrEP delivery into community-based outreach services for PBFM
- Engage key stakeholders to boost demand, adherence, and retention.
- Ensure an effective supply and management of PrEP commodities.

#### **Program Coordination and Management**

- Oversee site-level implementation of HIV services.
- Supervise and support clinical staff to improve service quality.

#### **Quality Improvement, Monitoring, and Reporting**

- Monitor HIV care cascades and support quality improvement initiatives.
- Prepare and share technical reports with project teams.

#### **Coordination and Compliance**

- Represent the project in coordination and technical working group meetings.
- Ensure adherence to ethical standards and national policies.

#### **Education and Experience Requirements**

##### **Required Qualifications**

- Bachelor's degree in medicine or Higher advanced diploma in Clinical Medicine, Diploma in Nursing, or a related medical field.
- Minimum 3 years of experience in HIV/AIDS clinical service delivery, coordination, training, or quality improvement.
- Demonstrated experience implementing PrEP, HIV, and STI services.
- Strong knowledge of MOH HIV policies, SSAC structures, and PEPFAR priorities.
- Experience working with international donors and partner organizations.
- Ability to work in remote areas and resource-limited settings.

##### **Skills and Competencies**

- Strong cClinical, coordination, and supervisory skills.
- Ability to train, mentor, and provide technical assistance to health workers and community teams.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.



- Strong organizational and problem-solving abilities in fast-paced environments.
- Good report writing and documentation skills.
- Computer literacy in Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
- Proficiency in spoken and written English; Juba Arabic desirable.
