Organizational Background

International Medical Corps is a global, humanitarian, nonprofit organization dedicated to saving lives and relieving suffering through health care training and relief and development programs.

Established in 1984 by volunteer doctors and nurses, International Medical Corps is a private, voluntary, nonpolitical, nonsectarian organization. Its mission is to improve the quality of life through health interventions and related activities that build local capacity in underserved communities worldwide. By offering training and health care to local populations and medical assistance to people at highest risk, and with the flexibility to respond rapidly to emergency situations, International Medical Corps rehabilitates devastated health care systems and helps bring them back to self-reliance.

Essential Job duties / Scope of Work:

1. Dress in PPE in accordance with protocols and assist patient to ambulance when necessary
2. Clean and disinfect the facility high risk areas including ambulance after caring for COVID-19 patient
3. Empty buckets of vomit and stool in the latrine, disinfect them and clean them with soap and water (use brush if necessary)
4. Move the used scrubs from the clothes baskets to the laundry area to be cleaned and hang it up to dry in the COVID-19 Facilities



5. Wash and hang scrubs, gumboots, aprons, goggles and gloves and other material to dry.
Fold dried clothes and place in wardrobe
6. Prepare the dead body and disinfect before transferring to the morgue and handing over to the family members

Personnel Qualifications (Special training/experience required) provide 6-7 requirements:

1. Experience as a nurse aid or cleaner in a hospital or communicable disease setting or any related field is required,
2. Having received IPC training and Hygienist certificate course is a plus
3. Reasonable communication skills in English (spoken and written) and Arabic (spoken)
4. Previous experience as a hygienist within a communicable disease setting desirable.
5. Must be extremely flexible, willing to follow instructions and work within very strict guidelines.
6. Must have the ability to cope well in a stressful, highly charged environment
7. **Actively promote Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (PSEA) standards within IMC and amongst its beneficiaries.**
