## **BACKGROUND:**

African Parks is a non-profit conservation organization that takes on the complete responsibility for the rehabilitation and long-term management of national parks in partnership with governments and local communities. We currently manage 22 national parks and protected areas in 12 countries covering over 20 million hectares in: Angola, Benin, Central African Republic, Chad, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Malawi, Mozambique, Republic of Congo, Rwanda, Zambia, 7imbabwe and South Sudan.

Boma and Bandingilo National Parks are located in South Sudan's equatorial region with a combined area of 30, 000 KM <sup>2</sup>. The parks host the largest wildlife migration in Africa that covers over 120,000 KM2, and provides habitat for large populations of white eared kob, tiang, mongalla gazelle and bohor reedbuck.

#### JOB OVERVIEW:

The Construction Foreman will oversee and coordinate construction activities on site. This role involves managing a team of workers, ensuring projects are completed on time, within budget, and to the required quality standards.
