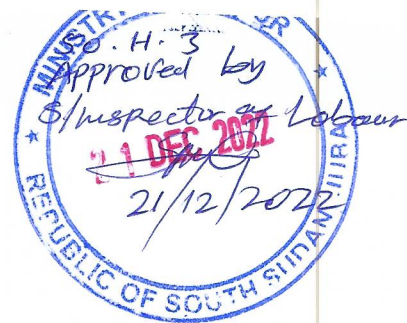




# Job Advertisement

## Surge Health Officer based in Pibor. Rolocation position.



**Job Purpose:** The Surge Health Officer will support the rollout of iCCM services in Lekuangole and Gumuruk, including recruitment, training and supervision of community-based health staff to provide screening, testing, diagnosis, and treatment.

### Key Responsibilities

#### Coordination/Representation

- Coordinate and build relationships with local authorities, humanitarian partners, and beneficiary communities
- Attend MoH, community, partner, or sub-cluster meetings, and other meetings when requested
- Consult with the Pibor Health Project Manager and Project Coordinator before making any commitment on behalf of Medair, whether verbal or written

#### Staff management

- Support with selection of Community Based Distributors (CBDs) and recruitment of CBD supervisors in Gumuruk and Lekuangole
- Conduct formal training and assessments with newly recruited CBDs and supervisors

#### Quality management/technical

- Continuously monitor progress against set objectives
- Ensure that all reporting and administration is done according to the relevant guidelines and is reported accurately
- Conduct on-the-job training and supportive supervision of community-based health staff and ensure that iCCM guidelines are available and followed

#### Logistics:

- Prepare field orders/stock requests for approval by the Health Project Manager
- Ensure accurate documentation for all stock keeping and stock movement in field location

#### Financial Management:

- Prepare and be accountable for field payments, manage funds in the field, balance receipts
- Ensure all financial policies and procedures are followed

### Person Specification/Qualification

#### Essential

- Clinical Officer or Medical Assistant Diploma; Nurse; Community Health Worker, or other health care diploma
- Experience with iCCM or other community-based programming
- Exceptional skills with Microsoft Excel, Google Docs, and ODK systems
- 2 years post-graduate work experience
- Fluent in spoken and written English and Juba Arabic

#### Desirable

- 1-year work with a similar organization
- Willing to learn new skills and sectors (hygiene promotion, nutrition)
- Experience working in Pibor or other comparable locations in Jonglei State

#### WORK CONDITIONS:

This is a field-based position, working and living conditions are very basic. The current security situation in Pibor is dynamic and the location of the interventions may be in areas of relative insecurity.
