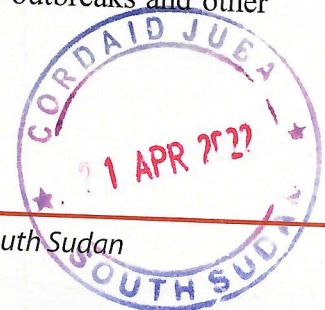

Reporting Lines

The COVID-19 Project Coordinator reports to the Project Manager TB/HIV. S/he will provide supportive supervision to regional/state level facilities.

Purpose of this position:

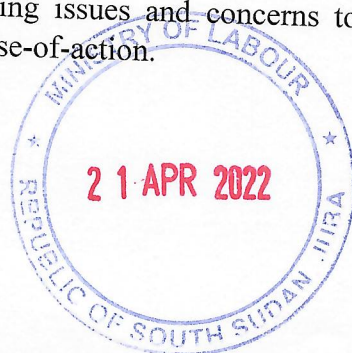
Provides support to COVID-19 preparedness and response functions. Support planning and documentation initiatives with regards to emergency operations, mitigation, and recovery efforts of COVID-19. Essential duties include outreach and educational functions in the community to monitor and improve vaccine related activities. Performs reporting and guidance review of MOH guidelines for COVID-19 Case management, prevention, and response activities. Participates as a member of the Technical Working Groups; shall respond to large disease outbreaks and other



Public Health emergencies anywhere in the states supported by Cordaid. This position will be required to be “on-call” as assigned or during an event.

Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities:

- Establish and maintain strong relationships with MoH directorates, including Directorate of Preventive services, National Steering Committee (NSC) for Covid 19
- Coordinate implementation of proposed COVID-19-related activities at the national and State levels, including around public communication.
- Directly support relevant departments of the Ministry of health in program implementation at the national level.
- Coordinate inputs from the Subnational Activity Coordinators, to enable a cohesive and strategic approach to COVID-19-related program implementation.
- Monitor overall activity progress against agreed targets, milestones, and outputs. Reports on findings as per the agreed timeframes.
- Conduct engagement and education efforts with new and existing providers and critical organizations to increase COVID-19 - response mechanisms.
- Participate in the development of standardized protocols and guidance for COVID-19 Case Management Guidelines and oversee the development of response training materials for providers, volunteers, and partners.
- Provide support in the procurement, management, and distribution of mission-critical Case management guidelines for providers, volunteers, and partners.
- Participate in the development of continuous quality improvement methods to provide feedback to partner agencies and incorporate direct feedback from partners and the general public to inform planning and response and improve case management, RCCE, surveillance and activity effectiveness.
- Participate in COVID-19 TWGs operations to ensure even distribution of COVID-19 case management guidelines.
- Assists with COVID-19 response clinic operations and non-pharmaceutical interventions and support call center function as assigned.
- Contribute to building the national capacity through need identification, development, operationalization and implementation of a capacity-building and training plan.
- Conduct regular and frequent coordination meetings with all subnational health and other sectors' partners, convene internal meetings to monitor and evaluate programme implementation, State work plans, facilitation of resource mobilization, prioritization, accountability of all stakeholders and effective decision-making.
- Provide the Cordaid country office with briefings, situation reports and event management information through the programme Manager health; to enable the overall continuous monitoring and planning process would feed into Cordaid's communication and advocacy products, situation reports, etc. bring issues and concerns to the attention of the Project Manager with a recommended course-of-action.



- Plan and coordinate training programmes of all health professionals on Covid 19 Clinical Management guidelines.
- Plan and coordinate Continuing Professional Development (CPD) in area of specialty for health workers.
- Dissemination/orientation sessions for guidelines.
- Update TB guidelines to provide for dual TB/COVID-19 testing and train health workers, lab techs, etc. on revised guidelines.
- Design/disseminate training manual/tools for BHTs for their roles (RCCE, surveillance) in COVID-19 response.
- Provide TOT to BHTs to undertake continuous, community-level risk communication activities.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the line manager.

Key Deliverables

- Monthly reports outlining key activities and progress in that reporting period and priorities for the following month.
- Presentation on progress, challenges, and future priorities in activity implementation as part of monthly and quarterly progress meeting with UNDP.
- A six-monthly report on the progress, which should include practices for effective, efficient implementation and replicability of activities, challenges faced and recommendations to improve COVID-19 case and community implementation strategy and maintain implementation quality.
- Other deliverables as required are based on the project and donor requirement.

Qualifications

- At least 5 years of experience with progressive responsibilities in managing program implementation, preferably in the field of public health, disease surveillance and control, epidemiology, emergency preparedness and response or other relevant fields.
