Purpose of the Position:

TITI Foundation is part of the South Sudan START Jub. which focuses on localisation, particularly enabling funding and support to local leaders on the frontline of the multiple crises in the country. We are tackling what we believe are the biggest systemic problems facing the sector: problems that include slow and reactive funding, centralised decision-making and an aversion to change, meaning people affected by crises around the world don't get the best help fast enough and unnecessary suffering results. In collaboration with the Hub and START Network UK we are running a Community-Led Innovation Programme in Kajo Keji, Central Equatoria State. This post will be responsible for the implementation of this programme including oversight of workplans, activities, budgets, reporting, compliance, safeguarding and a small team of staff and volunteers. This is a new style of programming which requires us to be adaptive, innovative and supportive of an entirely community-led approach to programming.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Lead and coordinate the programmatic, strategic and operational process of the Innovation Programme in coordination with the wider team.
- Take responsibility for compliance and high quality programme requirements with other partners and back donors. Strengthen and sustain the relationship with external actors that contribute to the innovation initiatives proposed by the communities.

 Delivery Design core content and activities that empower local community-led innovation. Communication – Help in the creation of internal reports and other communication to showcase program successes and learning.





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- Lead efforts to identify best practices, processes, methodologies for streamlined execution.
- Create & oversee a comprehensive long-term innovation strategy. Facilitate and drive workshops, ideation sessions, learning reviews and the practical aspect of day to day innovation.
- Provide technical guidance and review for all aspects of the innovation project working with technical experts in a variety of technical areas.
- Review & refine the programme structure, governance & process currently in place.
 - Collaborate, coordinate and engage with the Start Network UK and peer organizations in
 the South Sudan Hub to ensure they are informed and engaged with the programme,
 including seeking opportunities for learning across the Hub. Represent Titi Foundation
 and the START Hub in external spaces related to innovation processes.
