Organizational background

Major Responsibilities:

He/She will ensure the successful operation of the JESI program in Pigi canal, Fanagak, Nyirol and Ayod Counties of Jonglei State. The Roving WASH Officer will provide technical capacity, and overall leadership for the County teams and assist in the strategic planning and decision for the team in strengthening a decentralized WASH System in all the counties to improve delivery of basic water supply, sanitation and hygiene promotion services in each County. He/she will be responsible for overall monitoring and evaluation, reporting data and expenditures to the Project Manager.

The WASH Officer will be tasked with the following responsibilities: -



- Work with teams to provide technical support, planning, and coordination for all engineering WASH design in the JESI project sites.
- Conduct WASH design, engineering designs and other bill of quantities for all WASH activities in JESI project sites.
- Plan and implement hygiene promotion training, follow up routine BCC activities for internally displaced persons in the project site.
- Participate in assessments and other relevant studies in the project site to properly inform decision making.
- Conduct field visits, training of WASH technicians, HHPs and other WASH teams on WASH related activities.
- Produce program reports and success stories capturing achievements in the WASH project sites enabling integration with SGBV, Health and Nutrition
- Identify and conduct suitable WASH quality control activities at SWAT site and borehole points.
- Planning and implementation of water management committee training and supervision of WASH technician, and pump mechanics.

Qualifications/Experience/Skills

- Bachelor's degree in engineering (Civil/environmental/Water resource) with at least 4 years' experience in WASH programming.
- Capacity to use engineering drawing software.
- Knowledgeable with BCC methodologies in implementation of integrated emergency response with internally displaced persons
- Experienced with developing WASH tools, manual and other training materials.
- Ability to communicate effectively, team player and project management.

- Ability to handle work in a timely and accurate manner with tact and discretion, as required.
