IRC operates in 10 field offices including in Juba with program portfolio covering health, nutrition, EH, child protection, economic recovery and development (ERD)/livelihoods, women's protection, and empowerment, Education and general protection. IRC continues to provide life-saving assistance and humanitarian aid to vulnerable South Sudanese, trying to rebuild their lives and restore peace. The IRC's new strategy in South Sudan will prioritize improving health, safety, and economic well-being, targeting women, children, and other vulnerable.

JOB SUMMARY:

Internships are available at IRC to help students gain real-world experience in the work force. The IT intern will work in the IT department at IRC head office in Juba under the supervision of Senior IT officer. He or she will support the IT staff in software, hardware and all other technological tasks and issues. The position is intended to give new graduates a step up and gain work experience to help them pursue their career in IT.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

The IT interns will support the IT team in the maintenance and support of various hardware, software, and other IT systems. They will be expected to have skills in troubleshooting technical issues with IT equipment like computers, servers, and other peripheral devices. IT interns may participate in the installation, configuration and deployment of new computer devices including servers. They are expected to have knowledge of various applications such as Office 365 in order to support users. They may also research unusual bugs or issues the organization encounters. Other responsibilities include:

IT Network design, Cable Termination, and structured cabling

This task includes IT network structured cabling, Network administration including IP address
management, Internet bandwidth management and planning, Network monitoring and Network health
reporting, and Remote Support using applications such as Got Assistant plus learning to apply the various
theoretical knowledge learnt to isolate network related issues.

Printer Server management

• This role includes network printer set up and configuration, connecting computers to the network printers, troubleshoot any issues with the main printers, learn to change toner cartridges for all printers, Extract usage reports and share them with IT Manager monthly.

Domain User Support

- The intern will learn the concept behind domains and their use for the organization, joining and removing computers from the Domain. Understand various server roles in the Network and be able to isolate user login issues.

- Learn to remotely support users and possess strong communication and interpersonal skills in order to build trust with users. Be able to work with ServiceNow Helpdesk as the central portal for IT support requests.

 With support from the IT team the intern will learn how to install server 2019 on Virtual Machines and introduced to cloud computing technologies using hypervisors and help to configure active directory on the servers.
