## Job Summary

The main purpose of this position is to ensure that efficient and timely support provided to the CMMB WASH program sites. The wash coordinator shall generally oversee the implementation of both hard and soft ware of WASH components including civil engineering and Social Aspects, including installation of solarized water system, repair and maintenance of hand pumps, distribution of water purification sachets as well as water quality monitoring. The incumbent of this position shall ensure that CMMB is in compliance with government (Directorate of Rural Water) and WASH Cluster and coordinate with other partners implementing WASH.

#### SCOPE OF WORK

**Technical and Management:** 





Lead on WASH technical assessments within CMMB and other external sector agencies, including interagency assessments ensuring assessment findings are documented and that all assessments include a specific analysis of women and children's needs.

- Provide inputs to the development of concept notes, proposals, WASH strategy, details implementation plans and budgets.
- Identify priorities and technically assist on assessments, designing and overseeing KAP and other surveys
- Identify key gaps in WASH facilities and minimum standards in the WASH interventions by providing technical checking of WASH engineering and hygiene promotion aspects of the programme and proactively promote high quality WASH technical approaches for the response.
- Design water, sanitation, and hygiene interventions as per national and SPHERE standards etc.
- Prepare and oversee WASH programme implementation to ensure timely delivery of programme activities.
- Lead and supervise borehole drilling, repair of non-functional boreholes, CLTS and hygiene promotion activities.
- Develop program management/implementation tools for WASH programs in communities and health facilities.
- Prepare project documentation including weekly, monthly & quarterly project reports on implementation/ water purification sachets distribution, hand pump repair and maintenance status, as per requirements of CMMB

### Program support:

- Work closely with your line manager, to identify WASH programme supplies needs and coordinate to put in place a sensible phased procurement plan, budget and supply chain
- Coordinate with other partners and other relevant authorities (WASH Cluster) and administration to ensure coordinated implementation.
- Participate actively in WASH Sector Coordination meetings, sharing information from CMMB.
- Work closely with the M&E (Monitoring and Evaluation) team put in place M&E plan, ensuring this links to reporting requirements,
