

# Advertisement for Monitoring and Evaluation Officer Based in Rumbek

Norwegian People's Aid (NPA) South Sudan is an International Non-Governmental Organization involved in humanitarian, relief and long-term development cooperation in South Sudan. NPA has worked in South Sudan since 1986 and currently runs three programmes: Civil Society Development, Rural Development, and Emergency Response.

NPA is currently implementing Rural Development an Emergency Response Program Projects in Rumbek county, and will wishes to recruit a highly competent, proactive and self-driven individual (South Sudanese), for the position of **Monitoring and Evaluation Officer** to be based in NPA Rumbek Field Office. The contract for this position is Definite Contract with possibility of extension based on funding and satisfactory performance.

## **Purpose of the Position:**

Responsible for the implementation of the monitoring and evaluation, and learning framework of the NPA projects. Implement the M&E framework to ensure the qualitative and quantitative evidence are gathered from activities. Also provide technical assistance to the implementing staff and beneficiaries, particularly in relation to monitoring and reporting issues.

## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

#### 1. Design and implement M&E System and Tools

- Actively participate in the development of an M&E system and tools to enable all projects to collect, aggregate and support analysis of data.
- Work with staff to develop and standardize survey tools and other data collection forms for community-based discussions, cattle camp mapping, seasonal livelihoods planning, CBPP, activity planning and processes within project/program and stakeholders.
- Follow up the implementation of the M&E system, M&E tools, and project monitoring plans, including training and support in data analysis and usage.
- Support staff, partners and beneficiaries and ensure that they receive adequate feedback on progress on NPA programs.
- Document performance of the project against targets with special responsibility to qualitative and quantitative indicators and ensure reporting requirements are met.

#### 2. Data Collection and Analysis

- Participate in designing data collection tools, collect and analyses data as and when required.
- Collect, compile and analyze the data, in a timely manner, regarding different subcomponents/activities against envisaged project objectives.
- Capture significant change stories and reflects in progress reports.
- Follow-up on the data collection regarding field activities, baseline and impact assessment and ensure harmonization of data collection methodologies.

#### 3. Capacity Building of Program staffs and Partners

- Train staff on M&E tools, data collection, analysis and basic surveying and sampling techniques.
- Promote the principles and practices of beneficiary accountability to colleagues, providing training and coaching in beneficiary feedback and other good practices as required.

### 4. Proposal Development

- Participate in the development of project proposals through the provision of technical expertise using standard formats, providing relevant and well analyzed qualitative and quantitative data.
- Support in conducting need assessments for new proposal development

#### 5. Reporting

- Prepare monitoring and evaluation report for the project/program (i.e. PDM reports, ATT reports, FSL-Cluster Report etc).
- Prepare and submit the monthly evaluation reports for each project including the mid-term and end of project/project reports.
- 6. Perform any other duties that may be requested and assigned by the supervisor from time to time.
