Purpose of the position:

The purpose of the position is to provide technical oversight to WVISS WASH Program to contribute to World Vision South Sudan's strategic objective of improving health and well-being of beneficiary community through improved access to safe water and sanitation. He/she will provide technical guidance and building the capacity of the WASH program coordinator (national staff) on South Sudan WASH programming, including US based WASH reporting and maintain strong coordination with WVUS and WV East Africa Regional Office.

Key Responsibilities

Capacity Building

 Build the capacity of the WASH staff on WASH cluster mechanism and WVSS representation in various technical working group, among donors, UN agencies, stakeholders and relevant line ministries.

 Support technically the training of WASH staff and community hygiene promoters on aspects of PHAST, CHAST and CLTS. Coordinate WASH staff capacity building in the zones and also conduct monthly WASH review meetings/ presentations.

WASH budget management and controls

- Tracking WASH activity/works progress against payment and work plans, and controlling the quality of the final construction outputs as per donor and user community expectations.
- Support SCM in identification suppliers/ contractors and proper management of supplies/contracts for projects implementation.
- Liaise with WVSS Grants unit in tracking project expenditure, reviewing financial reports, and addressing queries related to expenditure in timely manager

Resources Acquisition

- Identify opportunities for expansion of WASH Program and also fundraise fund for extensive proposal writing.
- Participated in WASH project proposal and budgeting development and reviews.
- Coordinate the write of WASH capability statement and success stories on regular basis to support resource mobilization efforts

WASH project documentation and sharing

- Prepare WASH programme report (monthly project reports, Quarterly reports, Semi-annual reports and Annual reports) according to the donors' requirement.
- Coordinate and participate in project start-up/project closure workshops, baseline survey and end of Project Evaluation for the project as per project design and within the project implementation deadlines
- Coordinate review of WASH Business plan and capacity statement
- Submit 5Ws to WASH cluster on monthly basis

- Experience in WASH IPC integration health facilities (COVID 19 prevention, EVD and Cholera)
- Experience supervising construction teams/ contractors in water supply and sanitation construction works.
- Experience in conducting WASH assessment, including IRNA and MIRA
- Experience in GIS and remote sensing software applications.
- Practical experience in AutoCAD, ArchiCAD, water applications
