Job Title: Lab Tech Assistant (1)

Location: Akobo West - Walgak

Reports to: Clinical Officer

Contract Period: 12 Months

CHILD SAFEGUARDING:

ROLE PURPOSE:

The Lab Tech Assistant will be responsible for supporting the overall planning, implementation, and monitoring of Lab Tech management at the PHC/MMU sites to deliver reasonable services.

KEY ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure correct procedure for sample collection to clinicians and labelling with requests for patients well explained in a confidential manner.
- Assist Lab Tech and clinician to define and update laboratory activities, and participate in medical diagnosis and treatment of diseases in the PHCC/MMU.
- Perform quality RDTs for malaria, and or control tests and analyses, ensure compliance with the basic plans of the laboratory and ensure that tests are correctly performed while

observing Standard Operating Procedure. The holder will also maintain good use of RDTs at the PHCs/MMUs where necessary

- Ensure that hygiene and safety protocols, high infection prevention and control and required clothing and equipment are implemented in the laboratory including cleaning personnel being informed about biohazards accordingly.
- Ensure proper registration and records of all lab-related activities; prepare and send slides/samples for external quality control if necessary; check and oversee the proper maintenance of equipment (e.g. updated inventories of laboratory materials and equipment) etc.
- Ensure confidentiality of all patient laboratory results always, in accordance with the protocols in place.
- Manage, train and supervise the laboratory local team through capacity-building observing C-19 measures.
- Compile, analyses and report on lab activities/incidents or results and participate in the development of epidemiological reports and any other duties deemed to be performed as assigned by supervisor.
- Any other duties that may be assigned by the supervisor.
