This scholarship is a unique opportunity designed to empower young women in South Sudan by supporting them in their pursuit of a Bachelor's degree in Education.

What the Scholarship Offers:

The scholarship will provide full financial support for five female students to complete a four-year undergraduate programme in Education at a recognised university or higher learning institution in South Sudan. This initiative is part of WTI's commitment to transforming lives through education, particularly for those affected by conflict and displacement.

Who is Eligible:

This scholarship is open to female students who meet the following criteria:

1. Academic Qualifications:

- Must have completed secondary education in South Sudan, passing at least five subjects, including Mathematics, English, and Religious Studies, with a score of 70% or above.
- For students who studied outside South Sudan, they must have scored at least a 'C' in Mathematics and English.

2. Required Documents:

- Authenticated copies of academic certificates.
- A copy of birth certificate or age assessment.
- Two recent passport-sized photos (with your name and signature on the back).
- A school leaving certificate or a letter from the former head teacher or senior teacher.
- A reference letter from a community leader, parish priest, or elected official.
