PROJECT BACKGROUND:

BBC Media Action is conducting research on drivers to feeding behaviors of children 0-23 months in South Sudan. The primary focus of this study is to understand the decision-making process relating to feeding behaviors of mothers /caregivers of young children (0-23 months). It will focus on ethnographic factors, to recognize key drivers, actors and barriers influencing child feeding behaviors in various geographic and cultural settings to guide decision-making and program-planning.

The field work will consist of ethnography, focus group discussions and in-depth interviews.

OVERALL, PURPOSE OF THE JOB:

BBC Media Action seeks to recruit three supervisors to support and monitor research activities in the following locations: Pibor, Malakal and Aweil. The supervisors will be part of a team based in Juba and will be required to travel to the selected areas for data collection.

Main Duties:

The main duties of the supervisors will include but not limited to:

- Coordinate with community mobilizers to recruit suitable participants.
- Attend a training on qualitative research and other relevant policies.
- Moderate focus group discussions and in-depth interviews.
- Supervise research assistants in the field.
- Come up with debrief notes after the focus group discussions and in-depth interviews.
- Hold debriefs with the BBC Media Action throughout the research period.
- Conduct data transcription.

PERSON SPECIFICATION - REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND EXPERIENCE

- Experience conducting qualitative research, especially in rural settings.
- Attention to detail and the ability to work accurately.
- Ability to manage own workload and good time management skills.
- Strong ability to communicate with different members of the team.
- Fluent in spoken and written English language, spoken Arabic and at least one other local language.
- Have completed a Diploma or Degree.
- Should bear South Sudanese National ID and be able to produce it
- Able to travel to areas outside Juba.

Desirable Knowledge, Skills, and Experience

- Experience working with media organizations in applied research.

COMPETENCIES:
