Organizational background

POSITION DESCRIPTION

This position for the MOMENTUM Integrated Health Resilience (MIHR) project, led by IMA World Health, will report to the County Project Officer, based at the County Health Department. MIHR will recruit and assign one dedicated provider for each supported health facility with experience and expertise in delivery of family planning services. S/he will be the point person in charge of provision of FP/RH care (scheduling, stock, reporting, client scheduling, and coordination of activities of FP-focused CHWs). Facilitate adolescent and youth responsive FP/RH care and contribute to community engagement activities. Maintain cordial relations with government and partner colleagues.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide quality, voluntary family planning services and expand contraceptive choices through provision of information in selected facilities.
- Perform specialized counseling on family planning using the appropriate protocols and guidelines; elicit clients past medical history related to sexual activity and presenting symptoms (i.e., previous STI s, pregnancy, contraceptive history, etc.) for appropriate FP method provision.
- Support and promote the quality of family planning services; collect, review, discuss, analyze, interpret, and use health facility family planning data.
- Ensure the availability of adequate family planning supplies and other commodities, to ensure quality services.
- Provide implant and IUCD insertions and removals as requested.



- Ensure confidential documentation and storage of family planning client information.
- Outline clear follow up strategy for tracking and management of clients who may experience family planning-related side effects.
- Work with community health workers to increase demand for family planning services at the community level.
- Maintain standard infection control.
- Performs all other related duties involved in the family planning service provision as assigned or required.

REQUIREMENTS

- Nurse or clinical officer with experience as a family planning provider
- Hands on experience in a setting that provides FP/RH care (e.g. post-abortion care, IUD services)
- Must have at least five years of experience in a clinical setting
