

Objective of the poste: Key tasks &	The Partner Coordinator is the overall responsible (50%) for the implementation of the above-mentioned project through the local partner and will coordinate and monitor all related activities in the project area together with the local partner. For the remaining 50%, he/she will be tasked to act as link between Caritas Switzerland and other implementing partners of other projects, depending on the needs. In addition, he/she will be the main point of contact for the project stakeholders and will represent Caritas Switzerland at local and regional level.
responsibilities	 Project management: Responsible for supporting the implementing partner in the planning and management of the activities of the new Community Empowerment Support To Women and Girls project in Central Equatoria State and Pibor Administration area, in compliance with the rules and regulations of the donor and Caritas Switzerland (50%) Responsible for any other project(s) that might come up (50%) Provide supervision and quality controls for project partners and service providers Ensure that the monthly/quarterly/annual programme monitoring plans are followed and ensure adherence to M&E guidelines and frameworks (together with the M&E officer and HQ) Coordinate data-collections for the baseline/midline/endline survey Ensure good coordination and communication between the project stakeholders Keep an overview and monitor the progress of the project according to the set budget, timeframe and objectives and ensure appropriate human resources and logistics Coordinate and liaise with communities, implementing partner, government and UN agencies to ensure project objectives are achieved and to avoid duplications Systemically monitor and evaluate the project progress, effectiveness and impact of the activities and ensure strategic reflection to support achievement of outcomes and impact Write and compile timely progress reports as per agreed reporting schedule and in coordination with the partner, the Country Director and HQ



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- In coordination with the Country Director, organise coordination meetings (kickoff/inception), assessments, consultancies, project visits, workshops, mapping exercises
 and training sessions for involved partners
- Conduct regular field visits to identify needs, gaps, and challenges and to collect lessons learnt and best practices
- Coordinate advocacy, communication and visibility activities of the project
- Ensure proper documentation of the partner and properly maintain project-related documents and relevant records and reports
- Ensure proper oversight of the budget and financial planning and management of the project in accordance with Caritas Switzerland's standards and regulations (with support from the local financial team as well as HQ of Caritas Switzerland)

Further tasks:

- Proactive engagement, e.g. if revisions are needed, proactively communicate with the Country Director and suggest corrective actions when needed
- Monitor closely the general humanitarian and security situation in the project locations
- In coordination with the Security Focal point person and other security stakeholders, ensure risk management in relation to the implementation of activities and with all partners
- Analyse and report on any difficulties, challenges or security incidents related to the project
- In case of need and upon request, assist in drafting new project proposals, including needs assessments, mapping exercises, reports
- Coordinate and liaise with local authorities in the project areas
- Exchange information and coordinate with other actors and stakeholders (concerned UN agencies, the governmental bodies etc.) in coordination with the Country Director
- Participate and represent Caritas Switzerland in relevant coordination group meetings, cluster meetings and donor meetings at State level and report back to the consortium partners on key decisions and outcomes
- Facilitate missions from HQ and technical consultants
- Assist the Country Director in monitoring the Caritas Switzerland country program as requested
