### **BACKGROUND:**

African Parks is a non-profit conservation organization that takes on the complete responsibility for the rehabilitation and long-term management of national parks in partnership with governments and local communities. We currently manage 22 national parks and protected areas in 12 countries covering over 20 million hectares in: Angola, Benin, Central African Republic, Chad, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Malawi, Mozambique, Republic of Congo, Rwanda, Zambia, Zimbabwe and South Sudan.

Boma and Bandingilo National Parks are located in South Sudan's equatorial region with a combined area of 30, 000 KM<sup>2</sup>. The parks host the largest wildlife migration in the World that covers over 120,000 KM<sup>2</sup>, and provides habitat for large populations of hartebeest – Buffalo – Elephant – Giraffe & Lions.

### **JOB OVERVIEW:**

The primary purpose of the Clinical Officer will be responsible for delivering quality healthcare services, managing emergency cases, and supporting staff health initiatives aimed at improving the health of individuals working in Boma National Park.

### **MAIN ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

#### **Clinical Care:**

- Provide diagnosis and treatment to staff with various health issues within our scope of care, refer staff to correct medical centres for further treatment.
- Performing routine medical and surgical procedures.
- Ordering and interpreting medical test to the staff and in during emergencies around the parks.
- Providing comprehensive and high-quality clinical services to patients.
- Conduct Referrals to other practitioners or specialists when necessary.

#### **Health Education:**

- Conduct regular health education and Promote preventive health practices to Park staffs.



**Record Keeping.**

- Maintaining accurate medical drugs records and complete patients records
- Document all aspects of patient care.

**Reporting:**

- Maintain accurate and up-to-date patient records, reporting on health statistics as required.

**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:**

- Has a valid national Registration to practice as Clinical Officer with the relevant medical board.
