- The Clinical Officers will work under the guidance of and support of the Health Manager and senior Clinician at CMD supported health facilities.





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Primary Responsibilities

Quality Health Care Services

- History taking, physical examination, ordering appropriate laboratory investigations and make appropriate diagnosis.
- Promote rational drug use through use of MOH treatment guidelines
- Champion TB case finding and key GBV services at OPD.
- Attend to emergencies presenting to the clinic and recommend referrals for cases that cannot be managed as per MOH guidelines and facility level.
- Ensure that all required observations and vitals, prescribed treatment and procedures are carried out and documented on patients' records and HMIS registers
- Boost patient experiences, including counselling and sensitizing patients through health talks preventive and promote health.
- Embrace, learn and develop in an evidence-based medical system
- Consistent track record to work and deliver results with minimum supervision.

Drugs/Supplies

- Work with pharmacist on essential drugs required at the health facility and ensure rational use.
- Work with pharmacist and drug dispenser staff to ensure pharmacovigilance is applied on general outpatient drugs.

Laboratory

- Work together with the Lab staff to ensure relevant investigations are done on a timely manner with the correct results and ensure quality control at all times.

Trainings

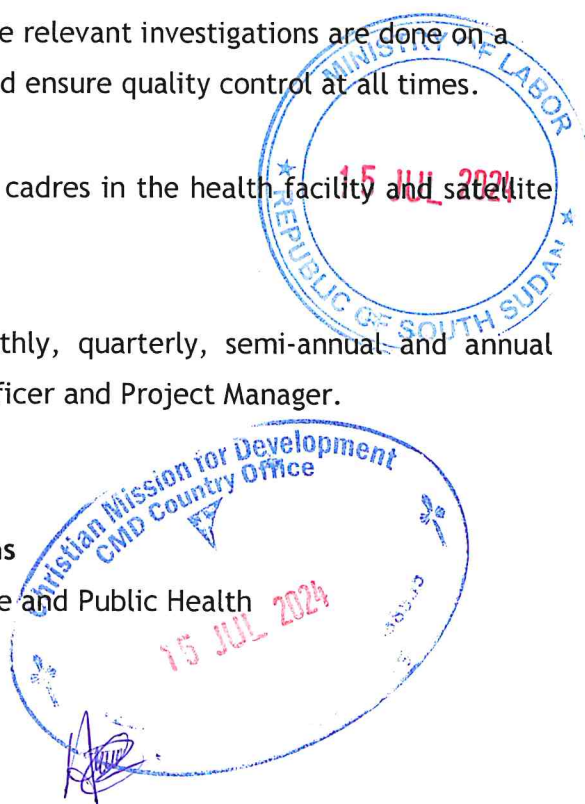
- On Job Training of CHW and other lower cadres in the health facility and satellite clinics as appropriate.

Report Writing

- Assist in preparing and presenting monthly, quarterly, semi-annual and annual reports with the guidance of the MEAL Officer and Project Manager.
