Responsibilities:

Under the direct supervision of the DFA, the incumbent of the post is required to perform the following specific duties and responsibilities:

- Driving of 4WD vehicles on all terrains.
- Transport of authorized personnel to and from their assigned offices or working positions.
- Knowledge and use of alternative roads, in case of roadblocks and emergency situations.
- Knowledge of Juba road maps, including Juba city and locations of all Government offices, other clients, NGOs, and public facilities etc.
- React professionally in crisis and emergency situations.
- Able to go on mission trips with overnight stays and prepared to work on extended hours as required.
- Delivery and collection of mails, documents and other items and deliver the same to assigned destinations.
- Meet official personnel at the airport and facilitates immigration and customs formalities in the absence of the Logistics Manager as required.
- Responsible for the day-to-day maintenance of the assigned vehicle, in accordance with the
 vehicle check lists and perform minor repairs as may be required and ensures that the vehicle
 is kept clean and in road worthy condition.
- · Report on mechanical faults and/or damage to the body or lights.
- Maintains accurate, up-to-date records on trip sheets, customer transportation forms, vehicle maintenance, fuel purchases/Refilling, incident reports, accident reports, vehicle condition reports and other records that are requested from management.

- Ensures that the steps required by rules and regulations are followed in case of involvement in accident.
- Ensure that at least one car is always parked at Rahwa apartment to facilitate any transport emergency of the expert staffs during night hours.
- · Performs any other duties as required by the project.
