The Carter Center is currently seeking to recruit dynamic, qualified candidates for the position of Truck/Light Vehicle Mechanic to be based in Kapoeta (EES), South Sudan.

Job Purpose: The Truck/Light Vehicle Mechanic, under the overall supervision of the Fleet Manager, support field activities of Community-Based Programs of the Ministry of Health - RSS supported by The Carter Center.

Key Responsibilities:

- Daily routine checkup for all the general preventive maintenance on Ural/Kamaz Trucks, Generators and Light vehicles.
- Assist the Fleet Manager by inspecting each vehicle to verify that it is in good condition, drawing maintenance plans, and completing fleet mechanical evaluations and disposal plans.
- Be responsible for prioritizing and scheduling service to utilize the workforce and time available
- Assist the Fleet Manager in identifying the relevant needs and quantities for purchasing all spare parts, consumables and supplies necessary for adequately maintaining all vehicles.
- To report immediately to the Fleet Manager any Violations of TCC Transportation policy or the Code of Conduct.
- Every vehicle must have a vehicle file for archiving systematic documents and compiled service records, referring to a detailed job card, specified works carried out, spare parts supplied and all related service and maintenance records for the respective vehicles.
- Monthly fleet maintenance records for each vehicle will be submitted electronically and in hard copy to the Fleet Manager.
- Perform any welding works/fabrication.
- Troubleshoot vehicle electrical system.
- Conducts regular inspections of the electrical system and wiring of the vehicles and Generators in the fleet.
- Identify and diagnose issues with vehicle electrical systems and install and repair electrical wiring systems.
- Do regular workshop tools inventory and report to the Fleet Manager any discrepancies.

- Clean and Valid Driving License approved by the Government of South Sudan

- Minimum qualification; Completed High school, Tertiary training or Vocational training in Auto mechanic would be of an added advantage, Mature personality, portrays a greater sense of humour

- Willingness to live and work in remote locations under basic conditions.
