Registered Nurse will be responsible for the patients care care. He/She will also be responsible for educating them and their families on prevention and healthy habits. The candidate will train the junior hospital staff and he/she will also be able to follow health and safety guidelines faithfully and consistently.

Major Responsibilities:

- Monitor patient's condition and assess their needs to provide the best possible care and advice
- Observe and interpret patient's symptoms and communicate them to physicians
- Collaborate with physicians and nurses to devise individualized care plans for patients
- Perform routine procedures (blood pressure measurements, patient care etc.)
- Ensure implementation of 6 patient rights medication in all the shift.
- Inspect the facilities and act to maintain excellent hygiene and safety (decontaminating equipment, sanitizing surfaces, preparing beds etc.)
