CHILD SAFEGUARDING:

Level 3: The role holder will have contact with children and/or young people either frequently (e.g. once a week or more) or intensively (e.g. four days in one month or more or overnight)

The WASH Officer will be responsible for providing technical support in the implementation of WASH projects both hardware and software components of WASH program including construction and drilling/rehabilitation of water facilities and generating BOQs, technical drawings/ designs and day to day supervision of field activities to ensure quality service delivery. The duty holder shall remain responsible for all the software components that includes but not limited to; Community mobilization and capacity building trainings, HESAN awareness activities, home improvement campaigns, CLTS, PHAST and CHAST hygiene methodology rollout trainings, and WASH data collection.

SCOPE AND AUTHORITY

The job holder is accountable for fulfilling his or her roles and responsibilities in line with Islamic values and principles of fairness, humanity, honesty, respect and fair treatment of his/her colleagues and staff.

Responsibility for Resources: None. KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- The WASH officer shall be responsible to develop and share all the relevant work plans to aid effective and timely project implementation.
- The WASH Officer will conduct continual review of technical designs and functionality of water supply systems and hand pumps to ensure efficient operation as well as reliability and supply of clean portable water for targeted communities.
- Regularly monitor IDPs and host community water supplies and estimate water requirement vis-à-vis the production of water from wells and hand pumps within the area.
- The duty holder shall fully participate in the development of BoQs and designs for all WASH infrastructural interventions with support from the WASH Engineer on the various projects including but not limited to latrines construction, borehole drilling and rehabilitations, etc.
- Work with the WASH team to design templates, construction BoQs for WASH related works, and a develop systems for monitoring work progress of the various project activities and performance of hired contractors.

Provide rigorous supervision of WASH software and hardware works in the various areas of IRW'S operation.
