Position Title: Drilling Coordinator

Since 1998 World Relief has been working with the local Church to address humanitarian and development needs related to Health, Nutrition, Food Security & Livelihoods (FSL), Education, WASH (Water, Sanitation & Hygiene), Protection, Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR), and Church Empowerment.

JOB SUMMERY

The Drilling Coordinator main responsibilities will be planning, organizing and manage resources of the overall drilling operation, water quality test, pump installation and borehole sitting. The coordinator will also be responsible in coordinating and leading community mobilization in line with the drilling activities, and submitting regular reports on the work being completed.

As a driller, he/ she will be required to travel to different work sites of the two locations, mostly on foot and support the team.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead and participate in field assessments and geophysics surveys for productive borehole sitting.
- Prepare purchase plan for drilling supplies and consumables on time.
- Manage and coordinate the overall drilling operation, water quality test, well head construction and pump installation.
- Ensure the borehole drilled is in compliance with community needs, donor's requirement and national
- Conduct on-site drilling supervision and provide technical assistance to the drilling team in the process of drilling;

- Prepare well log, casing arrangements and well completion reports together with the GPS locations.
- Assume other duties assigned by the area coordinator
- Maintain a Christian witness to the communities

Education / Experience Needed

- Degree in Geology or hydrogeology
- Two years' experience working in drillings, preferably manual drilling technologies
- Experience working for an INGO preferred

Skills Required

- Fluency in English
- Preferred him to speak Arabic, and Nuer required
- Excellent communication, analytical and critical thinking skills
- Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively to large groups of people
- South Sudan driving license and ability to ride a motorbike preferred
