- Administer post-anesthesia medications or fluids to support patients' cardiovascular systems.
- Perform pre-anesthetic screenings, including physical evaluations and patient interviews, and document results. And evaluate patients' post-surgical or post-anesthesia responses, taking appropriate corrective actions or requesting consultation if complications occur.

- Perform or manage anesthetic techniques such as local, spinal, epidural, caudal, nerve blocks and intravenous blocks.
- Obtain informed consent from patients for anesthesia procedures and select, prepare, or use equipment, monitors, supplies, or drugs for the administration of anesthetics.
- Calibrate and test anesthesia equipment
