Description of Position

They will teach and develop reading, writing and numeracy skills in adults. Furthermore develop the problem solving skills in woman and girls.</p> <p>We are looking for a Facilitator that will stimulate a creative learning experience o woman and girls in women safe spaces in Juba and Wau. The facilitator will be responsible in design and developing teaching material, and evaluate and assess the performance of each client in the safe spaces.</p>
Responsibilities
<p>Teaching and spreading knowledge among the adults is one of the major job responsibilities of the facilitator. Following are some of the other common responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teaching women and girls how to read, write and count by creating different lesson plans • Utilizing various curriculum resources while providing education • Assimilating different goals, competencies, and objectives into lesson plans • Learning and utilizing the curricula that reflect the cultural, educational, and linguistic background of an adult student • Practicing various teaching methods like tactile, aural, and visual learning • Individual teaching to students based upon their learning skills • Providing real-world context or live examples to the students • Making each student to participate in the classroom activities • Maintaining weekly reports of students progress • Providing suggestion and feedback to students to help them progress and avoid re-doing same mistakes • Making necessary changes and implementing various improvement plans

- Assisting the participants during the community outreach programs
- Developing encouragements in students to learn new things
- Keeping track to ensure that the initiatives are being met by the program coordinators
- Use of interactive and participatory methods
