The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) together with United Nations International Organization for Migration (IOM), with technical support from the United Nations Mission in the Republic of South Sudan (UNMISS) and working in close coordination with the Ministry of Gender, Child and Social Welfare, and Ministry of Peacebuilding is implementing *“Derin Salaam: Redefining Youth Spaces and Networks for Peace and Security in South Sudan”* project. The funding for this project comes from the UN Peacebuilding Fund (UN PBF) and is being implemented in two states and one administrative area, namely: Jonglei State, Western Equatoria State, and Greater Pibor Administrative Area.

DESCRIPTION OF ASSIGNMENT

UNESCO-South Sudan seeks to engage in partnership with local civil society organizations to implement aspects of the project on behalf of UNESCO South Sudan Country Office and deliver the following outputs over 30 months.

Output 1.1: At-risk youth in conflict-prone areas have increased economic and psycho-social resilience.

Output 1.2: Young people have increased influence on South Sudan’s national and subnational Peace Processes.

Proposals should be submitted for one up to three geographical areas within a budget average envelope of \$250 000 up to a maximum of \$300 000.

No remuneration will be made to organisations for preparation and submission of their proposals.
