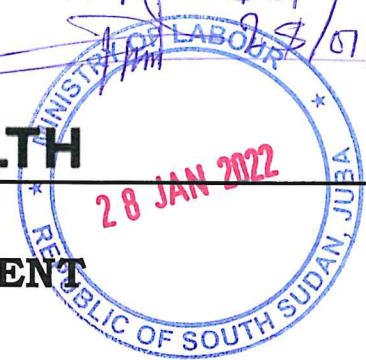

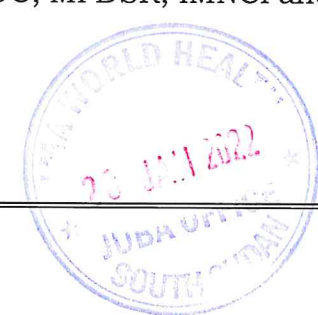
POSITION DESCRIPTION

This position for the MOMENTUM Integrated Health Resilience (MIHR) project, led by IMA World Health, the post will report to the MNCH Advisor, based in Juba Office.

Under the guidance and close supervision of the MNCH Advisor and with technical support of the Services Strengthening Advisor and Deputy chief of Party, the MNCH Coordinator is principally responsible for implementation of all related activities in the MIHR supported health facility. S/he is the MIHR focal person for RH/MNCH services delivery and work in collaboration with other health providers, prepare and submit report on weekly and monthly basis including quarterly report

Duties and Responsibilities

- To provide technical expertise and capacity building to Juba and field staff on MNCH activities in all MIHR supported health facilities.
- To provide technical inputs to strategies, workplans, guidelines, training materials and other document related to MNCH activities such as BEmONC/CEmONC, QOC, MPDSR, IMNCI and ICCM trainings.



- Work with the MIHR monitoring, evaluation, research, and learning (MERL) teams to develop metrics to monitor MNCH/FP activities indicators including tools to analyze and visualize performance over time, formative research, and M&E approaches as necessary.
- Provide continuous regular support to the MNCH mentors at all MIHR supported health facilities, provide technical assistance and clinical and non-clinical capacity building to the County-level FP/RH/MNH advisors and care providers in supported areas in Antenatal Care, Intrapartum Care, Postnatal Care at facility and community levels, psychosocial support and respectful maternal care, infection prevention and control (IPC) and handwashing, and clinical care for gender based violence (GBV) survivors.
- Liaise with MNCH advisor and services strengthening advisor to provide continued support to MNCH quality improvement activities at all MIHR supported facilities.
- Prepare regular and adhoc technical or travel reports to MIHR Country Office, HQ and for the donor as required.
- Represent MIHR at donor and other stakeholders' meetings including national technical working groups and coordination meetings as directed by the Chief of Party.
- Regular travel to MIHR supported counties and facilities to train, supervise, mentor, coordinate and collaborate with humanitarian partners to integrate, layer and sequence MNCH activities

Qualifications:

- Obstetrician/gynecologist, neonatologist, pediatrician, nurse or midwife with at least 10 years' clinical experience in MNH
- At least 8 years of experience in MNH for country level projects, for which at least 5 years were working in the field of international development focused on MNH
- At least 5 years' experience in clinical trainings and mentoring related to MNH
- Experience in M&E with the focus on MNH data collection, analysis and report writing.
- Post-graduate degree in public health is desirable.
- Excellent organizational, analytic, oral, and written communications skills as well as demonstrated supervisory experience.
- Ability to work well in a team and fast-paced environment and meet tight deadlines.

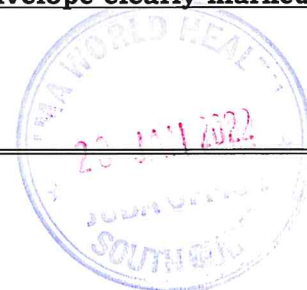
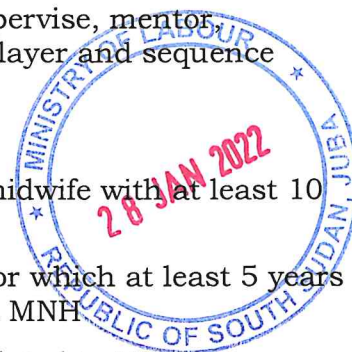
