Organizational Background

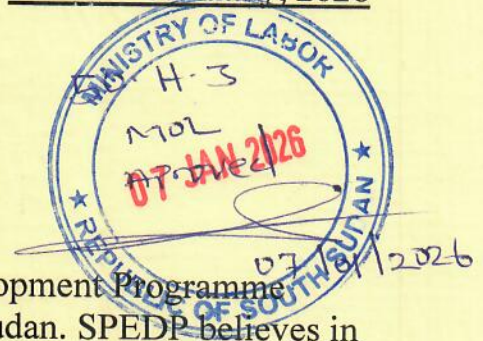

Position Summary

SPEDP is seeking to recruit a competent and experienced South Sudanese for the position of Generator Mechanic/ Operator to ensure the optimal functioning of our critical power generation assets. You will perform diagnostics, maintenance, and repairs on various generator sets, ensuring minimal downtime and maximum efficiency.



Core Activities/Key Responsibilities:

- Perform routine inspections, servicing, and preventive maintenance on diesel, petrol and gas generators and associated equipment. (e.g., Perkins, Cummins, Volvo).
- Operate diesel, petrol, monitor and control generator safely and efficiently and handle fuel management, including refueling, storage, and spill prevention.
- Ensure proper lubrication, cleaning, and replacement of worn or defective parts and compliance with safety standards, environmental regulations and company procedures.
- Respond to emergency breakdowns and power failures on a 24/7 or on call basis.
- Troubleshoot mechanical and minor electrical issues, including alternators, wiring, and safety devices.
- Conduct load bank testing and component inspections.
- Identify, order, and manage required spare parts.
- Complete work orders, maintenance reports, and keep tools secure.
- Train Junior staff or operators on proper generator operation and maintenance (if required)

Education Qualification and Experience:

- Diploma/Certificate in Auto Mechanics, Electrical Engineering, or related field.
- Minimum 2-5 years' experience in generator maintenance and repair.
- Experience with diagnostic tools (e.g., Caterpillar ET/SIS) is a plus.
