BACKGROUND

IntraHealth International, Inc is a US based, global health nonprofit organization that has worked for 40 years in over 100 countries including South Sudan .Currently, IntraHealth is implementing several projects in South Sudan with funding from US Centers for Diseases Control and Prevention (CDC) and USAID in collaboration with Government of South Sudan Ministry of Health (MOH) and South Sudan AIDS Commission. Our mission is to improve the performance of health workers and strengthen the systems in which they work so that everyone everywhere has the health care they need to thrive. IntraHealth's programs generate long term social and economic impact to keep communities around the world healthy, strong and prosperous. PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND SUMMARY OF ROLE

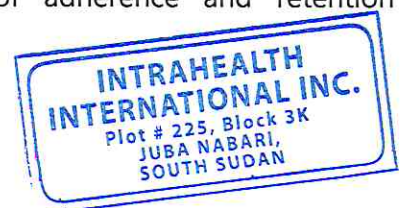
Advancing HIV & AIDS Epidemic Control (AHEC) Activity is a USAID funded consortium led by IntraHealth to create a community-led response and aggressively strengthen HIV services along the prevention-to-care continuum, paying special attention to case finding and retention. This four-year contract builds on IntraHealth's 15-year history of partnership in South Sudan as it works with the government to increase the effectiveness and efficiency of the country's efforts toward HIV epidemic control. Through a layered approach with local organizations and PEPFAR implementing partners, the South Sudanese government, and local communities, AHEC will build local capacity and resilience and adapt evidence-based HIV prevention, care, and treatment interventions for people living with HIV.

The PMTCT/EID Midwife will oversee the day-to-day planning and implementation of PMTCT/EID activities at the health facility.



ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Provide full time clinical assessment, management and care of HIV positive pregnant and breastfeeding women and their families for preventing mother to child transmission
- Provide clinical follow up, assessment and routine care of HIV exposed infants
- Provide early infant diagnosis services for HIV exposed infants including taking DBS blood samples for DNA PCR tests in line with MOH guidelines
- Follow up the baby –mother pair till when the last test outcome is determined in line with existing MOH standards
- Follows and documents all the EID test results in the appropriate EID registers as required by Ministry of Health
- Provide routine antenatal and postnatal care services to pregnant and breast-feeding women attending the ANC and PMTCT Clinics
- Ensure all pregnant women presenting at the health facility ANC and PNC are counseled and receive HTS services to identify the HIV positive mothers and exposed infants to be enrolled into care /PMTCT
- Support the counseling of all HIV positive mothers to ensure adherence to treatment and retention in care
- Provide HIV and AIDS information for all pregnant and breastfeeding women who attend the ANC, PNC FP.
- Provide infant and young child feeding counseling to mothers attending ANC and PMTCT clinics
- Follow up of pregnant and breast-feeding women and HIV exposed infants who missed their clinic appointments
- Maintain proper updated records of all HIV positive pregnant and breastfeeding women and exposed infants in the PMTCT Clinic
- Support the mentor mothers to provide psychosocial, adherence and follow up support to HIV infected pregnant and breastfeeding mothers and their exposed infant
- Counsel HIV clients on regimen specific side effects and dispense ARVs to clients
- Provide FP services and condoms to clients
- Establish system for documentation and reporting of adherence and retention interventions

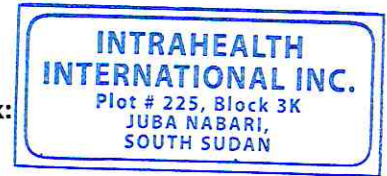
