#### Project background

Welthungerhilfe in South Sudan has been implementing activities in nine locations in the states of Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Greater Equatoria and Unity since 2011, with its programs in humanitarian assistance, rural development, livelihoods, nutrition and food security, and WASH sectors. Currently WHH South Sudan implements projects across the entire South Sudan.

Currently WHH South Sudan implements two projects in Rubkona County through the Bentiu Field Office. WHH has secured funding for an Emergency Nutrition Support Project in Rubkona County which purpose is to enhance access to improved Nutrition services. The project will target at least 30,000 participants including women, children and people living with disabilities.

## Job purpose

The purpose of this position is to provide technical engineering support and supervise, monitor, and report the construction and rehabilitation of Nutrition facilities and WASH related infrastructures in Rubkona County, Unity State. The position holder will coordinate and network with other stakeholders in the nutrition, WASH, Education, and other sectors in Unity State, including representing WHH at various related forums. The Engineer will support the development of Designs and BoQ for various construction and rehabilitation works including irrigation schemes as requested. 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#### Key responsibilities:

Provide technical support in engineering work to develop ensure standard construction work is undertaken in current WHH operational areas and other new locations while planning responsible exit when necessary.

- In collaboration with other technical persons within the WHH South Sudan program, develop BoQs, Scope of Work (SoW), design and technical specifications for Nutrition facilities construction and rehabilitation and WASH infrastructures, ensuring cost efficiency and adherence to relevant engineering standards
- Carry out contractor induction before the commencement of works
- Supervise and advise the contractor infrastructure construction from site selection to handing over of the structures
- Monitor the infrastructures to be rehabilitated as per the design, BoQ and scope of works
- Utilise monitoring tools for the day day-to-day monitoring of construction activities and share monitoring findings with contractors and project management
- Ensure day-to-day supervision of construction process including regular field visits and spot checks. Ensure strict adherence to contractual Terms of contractors
- Prepare technical designs, SoW and BoQs for any new construction works
- Take lead in preparation of weekly progress report, final report and drafting of completion certificate for the construction and drilling works
- Together with Logistics department, prepare tender documentation and undertake contractor pre-selection procedures to ensure that contractors meet minimum standards for the level of engineering contract being undertaken
- Provide technical support to the development of small-scale irrigation schemes, based on demand
- Project monitoring to ensure technical designs and drawings are followed correctly.
- Support logistics department in drafting SPRs for construction and WASH related materials
- Undertake regular field visits to monitor the effectiveness of the ongoing constructions, interact with community elders, local authorities
- Provide technical oversight and management to contractors to ensure high quality implementation of civil and drilling works, and advise the management on any arising issues
- Any other duties that may be assigned by Welthungerhilfe from time to time.

- Degree in Civil or water and environmental engineering
- At least three (3) years' experience in supervision of WASH and construction work, preferable in an INGOs setup
- Be registered as Engineer by the registering body of government of South Sudan
- Knowledge of and experience in gender dynamics in the local context of Unity State or wider national context
- Ability to understand, acknowledge and timely communicate one's own capacity and performance level and limits
- Advanced computer skills (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, AutoCAD)
- Experience in dealing with contractors
