PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND SUMMARY OF ROLE

The Advancing HIV & AIDS Epidemic Control (AHEC) Activity is a U.S. Department of State-funded initiative implemented in South Sudan by IntraHealth International to strengthen HIV prevention, care, and treatment services. The project approach focusses on Facility and community led responses, strategic case finding, retention in care, and the delivery of high quality, client centered HIV services.

The Strategic Information and Quality Improvement (SI/QI) Advisor provides technical and programmatic leadership in strategic information, monitoring and evaluation, health information systems, and HIV quality improvement and assurance. Under the guidance of the Strategic Information Director and senior technical leadership, the role ensures high-quality data management, rigorous program monitoring, and continuous quality improvement across HIV program interventions.

Key Functional Focus Areas:

- Strategic information and M&E leadership
- Health information systems strengthening
- HIV quality assurance and quality improvement
- Data quality assurance, analysis, and reporting
- Capacity building and mentorship
- Stakeholder coordination and technical representation

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES / ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Leadership & Coordination

- Provide technical leadership for Strategic Information, Quality Assurance/Quality Improvement, and Health Information Systems components.



- Lead capacity strengthening efforts for SI and program teams in data management, analysis, and use of data for decision-making.
- Coordinate with technical and program teams to develop and monitor work plans, indicator tracking tools, and approved monitoring frameworks.
- Represent the project in SI technical working groups, partner coordination forums, and stakeholder meetings.

Project Management & Technical Oversight

- Lead and coordinate quality assurance and quality improvement interventions at site and above-site levels.
- Ensure effective monitoring and evaluation of project activities, including impact measurement and documentation of results.
- Guide technical teams to ensure SI and QI interventions directly support program performance and sustainability.

Monitoring, Evaluation, Learning & HIS Support

- Provide technical oversight of electronic data systems including eRegister/EMR, DHIS2, and other health information systems.
- Plan and conduct routine Data Quality Assessments, data verification exercises, and quality audits.
- Lead updates of HIV indicators, data collection tools, and M&E SOPs.
- Support preparation of weekly, monthly, and quarterly performance review presentations and reports.
- Conduct national-level HIV data analysis and review program trends.

Capacity Building & Mentorship

- Design and implement capacity-building programs for SI, QI, and program teams at all levels.
- Mentor SI and program staff through supportive supervision, coaching, and learning sessions.
- Strengthen partner and MOH capacity in data visualization, dashboards, and analytics for program improvement.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Required Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Public Health, Health Informatics, Monitoring & Evaluation, Medical Records, or a related field.
- Master's degree in Public Health, Health Information Management, Epidemiology, Biostatistics, or a related field is preferred.
- Minimum of seven (7) to ten (10) years of experience in strategic information, M&E, or health information systems.
- At least four (4) years of experience managing HIV/TB strategic information functions in a PEPFAR-supported program.



- Strong experience working with MOH and stakeholders on SI, QI, and HIS strengthening.

SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

- Strong knowledge of HIV/TB SI indicators, PEPFAR reporting requirements, and data quality processes.
- Proficiency in dashboard development, data analytics, and geospatial visualization.
- Experience with DHIS2, EMR systems, and national HIS platforms.
- Strong leadership, mentoring, and facilitation skills.
- Excellent analytical, communication, and technical writing skills.
