Position Summary:

The Livelihoods Specialist will provide expertise in evaluating the Livelihoods components of the Youth Empowerment Activity (YEA). This role requires a strong background in Livelihoods programming, Youth development, Agriculture, and Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET). The Livelihoods Specialist shall report to the Evaluation Team Lead. This is a short-term position and will be from **January 2025 – March 2025**.

Key Responsibilities

- Assess the effectiveness of YEA's Livelihoods strategies, focusing on youth development, Agriculture, and TVET.
- Provide insights into best practices and innovative approaches to enhance youth livelihoods
- Develop and implement data collection methodologies to evaluate Livelihood outcomes.
- Conduct field assessments, including interviews and focus group discussions, to gather comprehensive data
- Gather insights and feedback from key stakeholders, including local businesses, agricultural entities, and vocational training providers.
- Facilitate stakeholder meetings to discuss preliminary findings and gather additional input. Contribute to the evaluation report by providing detailed analysis and recommendations on Livelihoods programming.
- Ensure that findings are actionable and aligned with USAID's strategic objectives.





Qualifications:

- Master's degree in Agriculture, Economics, Development Studies or related field.
- Minimum of 5 years' experience in Livelihoods programming, focusing on youth development and TVET.
- Experience with USAID-funded projects is highly desirable.
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills
- Ability to communicate complex ideas effectively
- Proficiency in English, knowledge of local languages in an asset
