- Support the schools, communities around the schools, local education authorities and state and county level government authorities to build and operationalise early warning systems and disaster management plans
- Support communities around supported schools on adopting climate sensitive agricultural practices.
- Build the capacity of Environmental/DRR clubs in schools to take lead on conservation, climate sensitive practices and green advocacy and awareness creation on climate change issues.
- Support schools to establish model plots to support home grown school feeding concept in supported schools.
- Build the capacity of consortium partners staff on climate change and adaptation/DRR and other best practice guidelines
- Provide support to school and communities in building/rehabilitation of flood mitigation infrastructure (dikes, flood protection platforms etc.)
- Train Communities around schools/WFP FFE supported schools on molding fuel efficient stoves and alternative/clean energy.
- Support schools to establish DRR-Sub Committees in schools for review of emergency response and contingency plans.
