



Terms of reference

Conflict analysis for Greater Jonglei

Purpose

Catholic Relief Services (CRS) is implementing the Building a Culture of Social Cohesion and Peace (BCSCP) program funded by the European Union under the instrument contributing to stability and peace (IcSP) in Greater Jonglei. The program is being implemented for a period of 18 months from 1 October 2020 to 31 March 2022.

CRS seeks the services of a consultancy provider to undertake periodic conflict analysis for BCSP in the targeted project areas.

The specific objectives of the consultancy are to:

1. Produce a conflict analysis that identifies the current (early 2021) state of conflict within and between communities in Greater Jonglei, including current and evolving drivers, triggers, and actors within and without the region;
2. Provide recommendations to inform CRS conflict prevention activities for the coming three-month period.

Experience and qualifications expected

- Advanced university degree in relevant field;
- 3-5 years' experience of programming in conflict management;
- Experience of research or work in Pibor, Duk, Ayod or Uror in Greater Jonglei;
- In depth knowledge of conflict contexts in the Greater Jonglei;
- Knowledge and experience of implementing conflict analysis;
- Excellent skills in research, analysis and concision in reporting;
- Proven capacity to write analytical, clear and concise reports on conflict dynamics;
- Experience of working with secondary data analysis/desk reviews
- Experience of developing research tools and carrying out research
- Fluency and concision in written English.
