In order to realize this, VWB/VSF Canada intends to procure 150 goats and 800 Chickens (local indigenous breeds) to be distributed to a target of 350HHs in Torit County. Indigenous breeds (100 does) and (50 bucks) are to be distributed to 50 vulnerable households to yield high-quality meat and milk. These breeds have the following characteristics; prolific nature enables it to survive in harsh climatic conditions and their long search for pasture and water can be suitable for cross-breeding purposes with the aim to build resistant breeds to harsh climatic conditions with the ability to survive compared to the imported hybrid of goat are opposed to the harsh climatic condition which affects their adaptability to the varying ecological zones of South Sudan where it is to be raised. With the above analysis, the implementation team in Torit has resolved to procure the local breed within Torit County or in Eastern Equatoria Region.

- Indigenous local breeds are preferred because of their prolific nature i.e tolerance to harsh climatic conditions, pasture, and water, and their ability to produce milk for human consumption in these torrid environments.
- Does and bucks should be at age of puberty and age at first conception/Parturition are preferred because of their ability to cope with changing environment and good indicators of sexual maturity.
- The Goats should be healthy, i.e. actively eating, with good vision, hearing, and breathing, and free from zoonotic diseases. There should be no major physical injuries and no limping.
- Feed continuously, are friendly, and scavenge well with normal body shape.
- The supplier has to procure the local breed goats within Torit, and Kapoeta regions to determine the breeds.
- The County Veterinarian Officer shall certify and issue a certificate of health for the Goats and chicken purchased.
- The supplier will procure and distribute the above agricultural inputs to the beneficiaries' designated locations or distribution points with clear instructions from VWB/VSF Canada:
- The supplier should be willing or have the ability to supplier more than the stated qualities of each of the goats and chicken.
- Supplier must be able to supply locally from South Sudan.
