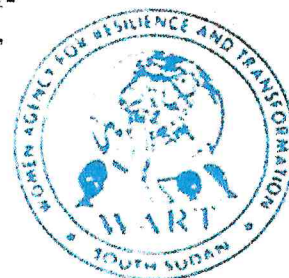
WART is currently seeking qualified candidate for the position of Economic Development and Food Security Officer.

### 4. Enterprise Development and Economic Empowerment

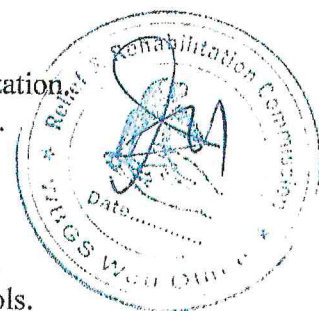
- Facilitate entrepreneurship and business management training.

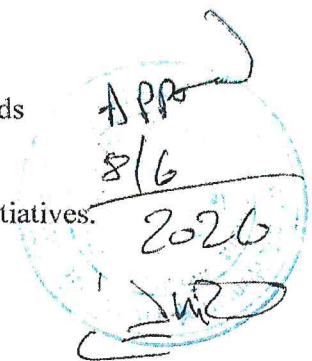
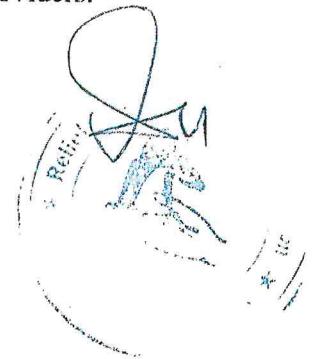

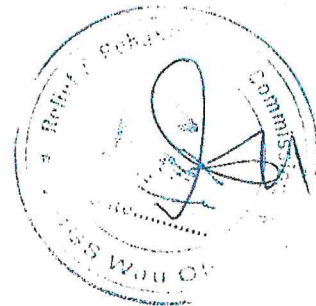
