### TERMS OF REFERENCE

Job Title : Cold Chain Repair Technician (CCRT)  
Number of Position : Two (2) Positions  
Duty Station : Juba with frequent travel to the field site.  
Duration : Six (6) months with possibility of extension  
Eligibility : This position is for South Sudanese nationals only

### BACKGROUND OF ACCESS FOR HUMANITY

Access for Humanity (AFH) is a national non-profit making, humanitarian, and developmental organization, fully registered under the laws of the Republic of South Sudan.

The mission of AFH is to see well-informed communities that are free from health-related issues, free from food insecurity, where there is social justice and gender equity, where women are empowered and women's and children's rights are protected, where everyone live in peace and coherence with one another in a sustainable environment, and where humanitarian crises are prevented and/or challenged.

AFH is serving the most disadvantaged communities of the Republic of South Sudan; that are living in the remotest areas of the country. Since early 2018, Access for Humanity is implementing and coordinating Routine Immunization (RI) and Polio Surveillance strengthening activities in over 30 counties in the Greater Upper Nile region of the Republic of South Sudan.

### GENERAL OVERVIEW OF THE POSITION

The incumbent shall work closely with the MOH and in collaboration with UNICEF, under direction of the AFH Project Manager, the overall guidance of AFH Chief Executive Officer (CEO), and the direct supervision of the McKing Cold Chain Repair Technician (CCRT), the AFH Cold Chain Repair Technician (AFH/CCRT) will install, repair and maintain cold chain equipment in the Greater Upper Nile region of South Sudan. He/she will also provide on-the-job training to county EPI and health facility staff on the management and maintenance of provided cold chain equipment.





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## **FUNCTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Work closely with MOH, UNICEF and Fund Managers/lead agencies to identify the cold chain equipment in his/her area of assignment and identify the type and status of each unit
- In coordination with the AFH Project Manager and under direction of the Lead McKing Consultant and the McKing CCRT, prioritize installation/repair of equipment in assigned counties and travel to field sites to effect installation, repair and maintenance of equipment
- For non-repairable equipment, prepare a recommendation for disposal and replacement
- Provide on-the-job training to county EPI and health facility staffs on the management and preventive maintenance of existing equipment
- Conduct on-the-job training on vaccine procurement, management and handling
- Provide a detailed record of vaccine availability and status at each visited health and vaccine-storage facility
- Maintain a detailed inventory of all cold chain equipment
- Perform additional relevant tasks as assigned by the supervisors.

## **SKILLS REQUIRED / QUALIFICATION & EXPERIENCE:**

- Knowledge of solar refrigerators BP VR50, NAPS, RFVB, Domestic, etc. and the installation of the Solar Direct Drive SDD refrigerators namely (VestFrost MKS044, SunDanzer BFRV55, True Energy BLF100DC, VestFrost VLS054 & Dulas VC200SDD)
- A minimum of three years' experience installing and repairing refrigeration equipment
- Ability to train and mentor local staff in the maintenance and management of both conventional and solar cold chain equipment as well as training on vaccine management and handling.
- Ability to write reports in English; basic computer skills
- Ability to work effectively as a team member and independently;
- Ability to manage multiple priorities under pressure, trouble-shoot, and to meet short- and long-term deadlines;
- Thorough familiarity with word processing, spreadsheet, and project scheduling computer applications;
- Demonstrated experience in budget and financial management.

- Excellent critical and creative thinking and analytical skills.
