Job Summary:

The PMTCT Focal Person will oversee and implement all activities related to the prevention of mother-to-child transmission (PMTCT) of HIV within the assigned health facility. Working closely with clinicians, mentor mothers, and community teams, the incumbent will conduct and ensure routine HIV testing for pregnant and breastfeeding women (PBFW), immediate ART initiation, retention in care, and timely early infant diagnosis (EID). The role focuses on improving service delivery, documentation, and linkage across ANC, maternity, ART, and EID clinics to ensure that no mother—

baby pair is lost along the PMTCT/EID cascade.

Key Responsibilities and Tasks:

- Conduct HIV testing for all pregnant and breastfeeding women attending ANC, delivery, PNC, and immunization clinics.
- Ensure timely ART initiation, VL testing, and EAC follow-up for all HIV-positive PBFW.
- Facilitate early infant diagnosis (EID), sample collection, results return, and follow-up of HIV-exposed infants.
- Monitor PMTCT commodity availability and support integration of PrEP and partner testing.
- Collaborate with mentor mothers and community teams to enhance retention and defaulter tracing.
- Ensure accurate documentation and timely reporting of PMTCT and EID indicators.
- Provide mentorship to ANC, maternity, and EID staff on PMTCT protocols and data quality.

Qualifications & Experience:

- Diploma or Bachelor's degree in Nursing, Midwifery, Clinical Medicine, or related field.
- Minimum 2 years' experience in PMTCT or maternal/child health within USG/Global Fund programs.
- Strong knowledge of Option B+, ANC, and EID workflows and indicators (PMTCT_STAT, PMTCT_ART, PMTCT_EID).
- Excellent communication, mentoring, and data reporting skills.
- Computer literate, fluent in English; spoken Arabic an advantage.
