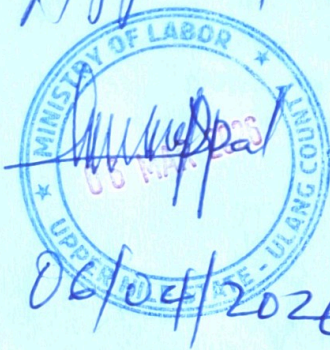
I. Presentation of organization:

In particular, he/she helps in ensuring the quality of implemented projects through reporting follow-up, results monitoring, context monitoring, lessons learned and knowledge management, tools development and training.

The FSL Supervisor takes part in the development and implementation of Solidarités International technical FSL strategy in the WBEG State.

He/she takes on the functions of the Program Manager in case of absence to manage the FSL activities.

JOB

Main tasks:

Project quality

- To help in ensuring the quality of implemented FSL project through reporting follow up, results monitoring, context monitoring, lessons learned and knowledge management, tools development and training
- To work closely with the FSL officers and the Program Manager in coordinating information exchange and timely support.
- Collect information from the field and assist in the quality analysis of the activities carried out with the Program Coordinator
- Ensure that the activities meet qualitative standards and proposal expectations

Coordination, technical support and operational monitoring

- Together with the Program Manager, set objectives and specific and general indicators to assess and monitor the impact of the programs and to reshape them if necessary
- Organize and supervise the identification and registration of beneficiaries
- Organize and supervise the day-to-day monitoring and evaluation of the FSL projects (including post-distribution monitoring activities)
- Pass on any information or problems to his/her direct and/or indirect supervisor concerning his/her task, SI programs, or safety aspects
- Supervise and organize all assessments for the projects or for new projects, especially price monthly price and market assessment
- Analyze the humanitarian situation, taking protection problems into consideration/Do no Harm to the population.
- Propose action plan to ensure that beneficiaries and local populations both understand the project goals and actively participate in their implementation.
- Actively participate in the good collaboration with local leaders



- Act as a liaison with the local population and authorities to identify the needs, grievances and major events that could have potential consequences for SI activity
- Support Program Manager for carrying out and/or supervising task and resource planning over time, according to the objectives which have been set
- Suggest new tasks/projects as regards organizational strategy and proficient analysis of the situation (contribute to annual scheduling) to Program Manager
- Monitor the development of current FSL project (progress, suitability and effectiveness) and suggest modifications to Program Manager
- Together with the Program Manager, ensure and approve quality and adherence to guidelines and due dates set in any contractual documents (proposal, intermediate and final reports...)
- Support the teams on site, by regularly visiting intervention sites planned with the Program Manager, pre-empting problems and listening to the teams
- Ensure that local communities are closely involved in project implementation and that the relationship between Solidarités International and local communities remains harmonious, together with FSL officers and Program Manager
- Together with the Program Manager, be involved in the review and follow up of the different operational follow-ups.

Logistics and administration

- Contribute to the definition of the needs in materials and tools regarding the program and the planning of interventions.
- Ensure the follow-up and the proper use of materials and tools used during on-site work.
- Manage the supply of materials to the work site in collaboration with logistics department.
- Analyze the security situation in the area and inform the FSL PM in case of security incidents, rumors or any security information.

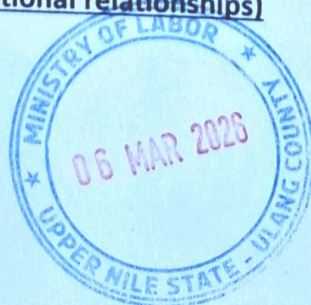
Knowledge management

- In conjunction with the Program Manager, establish and maintain a communication network and good relations with local/government authorities, financial donor representatives, UN agencies and other international agencies
